



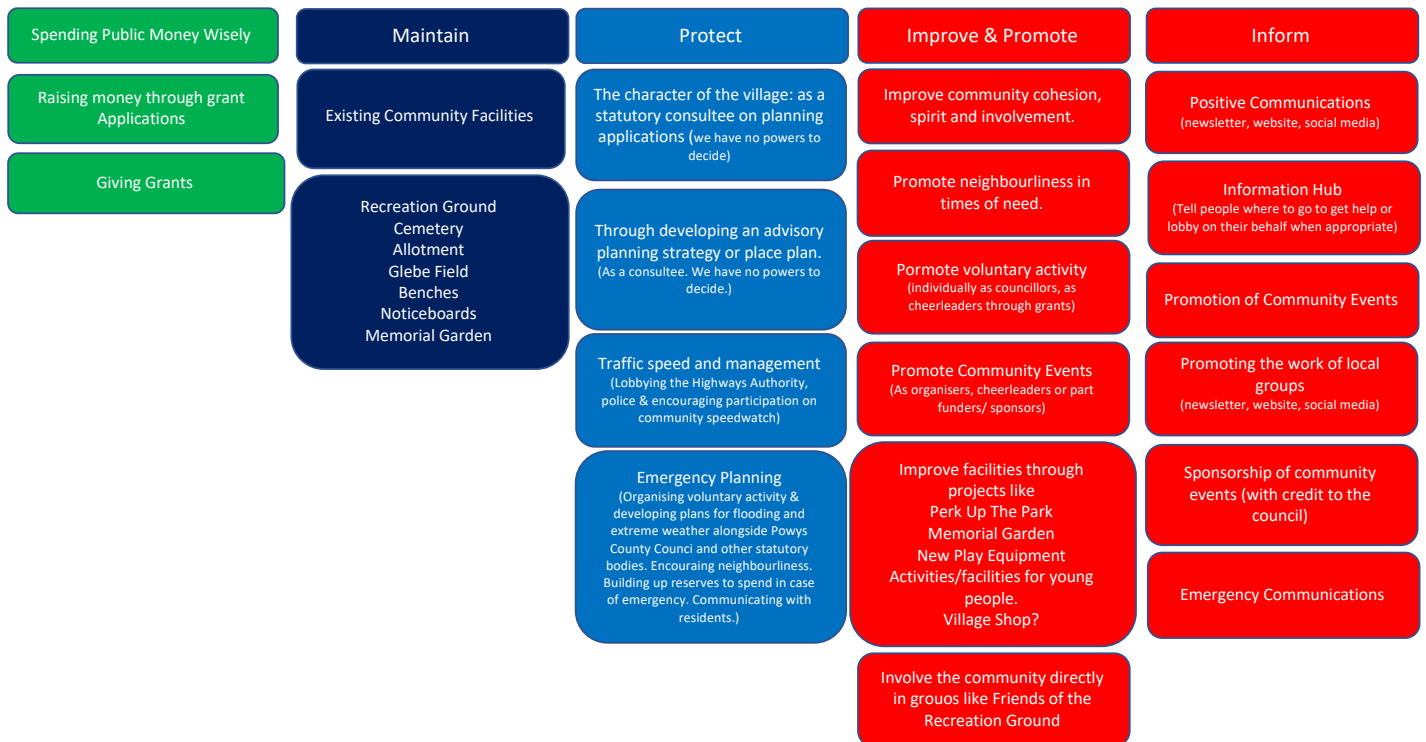
HAPPY NEW YEAR FROM LLANGATTOCK COMMUNITY COUNCIL

Aims and Objectives

The new structure allows local people to get involved directly in projects to improve the village, to seek grant funding for new ventures and plan for the future.
